In terms of the statements made on 16th November, 2015 by the Respondents' Advocate affirming the instructions orally received that the Petitioner is not blacklisted and that presently the first Respondent has not issued any tender notice for the works which have been carried out and subject matter of this Petition, nothing survives in the Petition.

2) In the event any fresh tenders are issued, in view of the above statements which are accepted as undertakings given to this Court, the Petitioner can place its bid/tender. That shall be considered in accordance with the terms as also law. There is,

therefore, no apprehension which can be entertained by the Petitioner. In the event the Petitioner is not allowed to place the bid or tender or that is not considered or the Petitioner is wrongfully excluded from the tender process, the Petitioner can challenge such action by instituting appropriate proceedings. All contentions of both sides in that regard are kept open. The Petition is disposed of.
