This appeal by the Revenue under Section 260A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 challenges the order dated 6 June 2012 passed by the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal. The impugned order dated 6 June 2012 relates to Assessment Year 2007-08.

2 The following question of law has been formulated by the appellant for our consideration :

“Whether on the facts and in the circumstances of the case and in law, the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal was right in holding that an amount of Rs.15 lacs received from M/s.Precimex Bearing Pvt. Ltd. is not deemed dividend as per provisions of Section 2(22) (e) of the Income Tax Act ?

3 The counsel are agreed that the above question of law stands covered in favour of the respondent assessee and against the Revenue by the decision of this Court in ***Commissioner of Income Tax v/s Impact Containers Pvt. Ltd.***, reported in ***(2014) 367 ITR 346 (Bom.)***.

4 Accordingly, no substantial question of law arises for consideration. The appeal stands dismissed. No order as to costs.
