(i) Statement of Affairs provided by the directors of Respondent No. 1 Company ;

(ii) Statement, details and status of all assets of which possession has been taken by the Official Liquidator pursuant to the order dated September 2, 2014 (including of fixed deposits maintained by Respondent No. 1 Company and the interest thereon) ;

(iii) Statement of all the assets / investments of Respondent No. 1 Company ;

(iv) Inspection of all records and documents in this regard.

(b) the Official Liquidator be directed to share with the Applicant, upon request received from the Applicant, all the information that his office shall receive in future in respect of the Respondent Company.”

3. The Company Application is accordingly disposed of.
4. Office to forthwith number the above Application.
