2. The learned Counsel appearing for the parties have tendered the consent terms dated 14/01/2015 duly signed by the parties and their advocates. The parties have agreed to equally distribute the amount of Rs.74,700/- invested in a fixed deposit by the Registrar, Industrial Court, Mumbai along with accrued interest. The learned Counsel appearing for the parties submit that the controversy between the parties is amicably settled and the petition maybe disposed of in terms of the consent terms. Ms.Yadav states that respondent is present in the Court. She identifies him. The consent

terms are explained to him. He admits and confirms the correctness of the consent terms.
