

installments set out in clause (3) of the Consent Terms, the Respondent shall make good the same by way of RTGS or Bankers cheque within seven days of such dishonour, the Company Petition shall without reference to this Court revive, stand admitted, made returnable within six weeks from the date of default and advertised in two local newspapers i.e. Free Press Journal (in English) and Navshakti (in Marathi) and in the Maharashtra Government Gazette. The Petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs.10,000/- with the Prothonotary and Senior Master of this Court towards publication charges, within two weeks from the date of default, with intimation to the Company Registrar failing which the Petition shall stand dismissed for non prosecution. In the event of such default the Official Liquidator shall forthwith stand appointed as provisional Liquidator and shall immediately take charge of the records as well as the movable and immovable properties / assets of the Company. Notice under Rule 28 of the Companies (Court) Rules, 1959 shall also stand waived on behalf of the Company.

3. The above Petition is disposed of in terms of Consent Terms marked 'X' as well as clarification set out in para (2).
