1. The Court Receiver's Report is allowed in terms of prayer Clauses (a)

“(a) Whether the Court Receiver should make the payment at the rate of Rs.4,500/- p.m. to the Society towards society maintenance charges from October-2015.

(b) Whether the interest on outstanding amount of maintenance of Rs.254/- shall be paid to Society by Court Receiver's office.

(c) That the cost of and incidental to this report be fixed at Rs.3,000/- and be directed to come out of the funds lying in his

hands as Receiver herein”
