2. On 23rd March, 2015 this Court (Coram : S.C. Gupte, J.) inter-alia passed the following order :

“4. That parties shall file their respective affidavits of documents together with their compilations and complete discovery and inspection within four weeks from today. The Plaintiff shall within two weeks thereafter file its affidavit of evidence in lieu of examination-in-chief”.

passed by this Court dated 23rd March, 2015. The Suit therefore deserves to be forthwith dismissed. However, since the learned Advocate for the Plaintiff undertakes to comply with the order passed by this Court dated 23rd March, 2015 within a period of one week from today, this Court as a last chance and only by way indulgence is granting a week's time to the Plaintiff to comply with the order passed by this Court dated 23rd March, 2015.
