The petitioners to move appropriate application giving necessary details within a period of four weeks from today. If such an application is received by the authority, the authority shall consider it in the light of law as laid down by this Court in the

case of Jaikumari Amarbahadursingh & Ors. vs. State of Maharashtra & Anr., reported at 2009 (1) ALL MR 343, within a further period of four weeks.

Thus, leaving all other contentions open, we dispose of the present writ petition. There shall be no order as to costs.
