Heard Mr.S.N.Gaikwad, learned advocate for the applicant and Mr.M.D.Lakhey holding for Mr S.J.Kadoo, learned advocate for respondent No.1.

The learned advocate for the applicant submits that the proceedings which were pending before the Civil Court at Murtizapur are transferred to the Civil Court at Akola.
