Heard Shri S.U. Bhuyar, the learned Advocate for the applicant/petitioner, Shri A.K. Bangadkar, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for the non-applicant/respondent No.1, 2, 3 and 5 and Shri R.D. Karode, the learned Advocate for the non-applicant/respondent No.6.
