Prayer is to permit the respondent Nos.1 and 2 to withdraw the amount of enhanced compensation that has been deposited by the appellant in this Court.

In the application it is stated that the respondent No.2 is a senior citizen and she has recently purchased residential flat.

The application is opposed by the appellant on the ground that enhancement is granted by the Reference Court on a higher side. Considering the judgment of the Reference Court and reasons assigned in the application, respondent Nos.1 and 2 are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount that has been deposited by the appellant subject to furnishing solvent surety to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial).
