Heard Shri S.S. Shingane, the learned Advocate for the applicants.

The applicants have filed the miscellaneous civil application praying for restoration of the first appeal which was dismissed in default as per the order passed by the learned Registrar, for non-removal of office objections within the stipulated time. As there is delay in filing the miscellaneous civil application, the application is filed praying for condonation of delay.
