Prayer is to permit the respondent Nos.1 to 10 to withdraw sum of Rs.36,84,513/- deposited by the appellant. Reason assigned is that there is absence of any source of income.

The application is opposed by the learned counsel for the appellant on the ground that compensation that was awarded by the Land Acquisition Officer @ Rs.69,000/- per hectare has been enhanced to Rs.20,00,000/- per hectare.

Considering the reasons assigned in the judgment, respondent Nos.1 to 10 are permitted to withdraw sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lacs) subject to furnishing undertaking that in case the appeal is allowed, they shall repay the aforesaid amount with interest at such rate the Court may direct.

C.A. is disposed of.
