ORAL JUDGMENT (Per P.N. Deshmukh, J.)

1. Rule. Rule made returnable forthwith. Heard finally with consent of the learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner has approached this court for grant of extension parole leave on the ground of illness of his wife which was granted by competent authority by its order dated 341.1.2015, for a period of 30 days.
3. According to the petitioner, considering the serious illness of his wife on 27.2.2015 he applied for further extension of his parole leave and in spite of sufficient time since lapsed, the application is not decided. In that view of the matter, we partly allow the petition as per order below.

ORDER.
