The learned advocates for the contesting parties i.e. petitioner and respondent Nos.1 and 2 submit that Special Civil Suit No.64 of 2014, subject matter of which was same, as the subject matter of this writ petition, has been amicably settled between the petitioner and the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and the civil suit has been disposed of in terms of the compromise.
