On the previous date of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioners stated, after perusal of the affidavit-in-reply filed on behalf of the respondents, that the only remaining grievance of the petitioners would be in regard to the grant of Rehabilitation Package benefits .

Shri D.P.Thakre, the learned Addl. Government Pleader, on instructions, states that the Rehabilitation Package benefits have been sanctioned to the petitioner nos.1 to 4, 6 to 8 and they it would be paid to the petitioners at the earliest.
