Heard learned counsel for rival parties.

It is not in dispute that the applicant was arrested on 15-3-2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 354, 452, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 7 and 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act and is in jail since then. It is not in dispute that investigation has been completed and charge-sheet has been filed before the competent Court. Looking to the nature of offences and the period spent by the applicant in jail, I think the following order would sub-serve the interest of justice.

ORDER

- (i) Criminal Application No. 213/2015 is allowed.
- (ii) The applicant be released on his furnishing personal bond of Rs. 5,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.
- (iii) The applicant shall not enter the Village Usagaon, Tahsil and District Chandrapur.
- (iv) Liberty is granted to the applicant to apply for modification of this order after three months.
