In the circumstances of the case, the respondent is directed to pay maintenance *pendent lite* to the applicant at the rate at which it was granted to the applicant for herself by the Family Court during the pendency of the Hindu Marriage Petition filed by the respondent.

The civil application stands disposed of.

At this stage, the counsel for the applicant states that the applicant is required to bear the expenses of the education of the son and the respondent is not fulfilling his duties in regard to

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that.

The counsel for the respondent disputes the statement made on behalf of the applicant.

The parties are free to agitate the said issue and the issue in regard to permanent alimony before the appropriate forum. Order accordingly.
