The directions dated 15.3.2013 issued by this Court only expected respondents to consider the entitlement of petitioner for regularisation in terms of Government Circulars. The order dated 15.3.2013 is a common order in W.P. No. 4951, 5677 and 5755 of 2012. The petitioners in W.P. No. 4951 and 5677 of 2012 had filed W.P. No. 2791/13 before this Court after the advertisement dated 17.5.2013 on account of their non-

selection claiming direct regularisation. That writ petition has also been dismissed on 28.10.2013.
