Shri Khamborkar, the learned counsel for the petitioner, states that the petitioner would approach the Civil Court, as some disputed questions of facts arise for determination in this writ petition. On the request made by the learned counsel, the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn. The points raised in the petition are kept open.
