Criminal Application (APPP) No. 564/2015

At the outset, learned counsel for the applicant submits that inadvertently, a prayer in nature of seeking issuance of directions that no coercive action be taken against the applicant in view of the statements made in paragraph 2 of the application remains to be added in the prayer clause. Shri Gode, learned counsel prays for amendment by adding said prayer as prayer clause (ia).

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the applicant, ad-interim relief in terms of added prayer clause (ia) till the non-applicant no. 1 causes appearance before this Court.
