Heard Shri N.R. Saboo, the learned Advocate for the petitioner and Shri A.S. Dhore, the learned Advocate for the respondent No.1.

2. After arguing for considerable time, the learned Advocate for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the petition. As the withdrawal is unconditional, the learned Advocate for the respondent No.1 has no objection, however he submits that exemplary costs be imposed on the petitioner.
