The application for extension of parole leave is rejected on the ground that the petitioner's father was not suffering from serious ailment which required the petitioner's presence. Perusal of the material placed on record would reveal that father of the petitioner is taking regular treatment. No document is placed on record to show that the petitioner's father was required to be hospitalized. Apart from that, the petitioner has applied for extension of parole leave after the date on which he was required to surrender before the jail authorities. In that view of the matter, the reason given by the

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authorities while rejecting the application for extension of parole leave is rational. No interference is called for and hence, the writ petition is rejected.
