Our attention has been invited to orders dated 05.11.2014 in Writ Petition No. 297 of 2014 and other connected matters. Shri Mundhada, learned counsel as well as learned AGPs submit that the present writ petitions may be disposed of in terms of directions given therein.

Accordingly, in terms of leave given to the petitioners in para 5 of the said order, we dispose of the

present writ petitions. The petitioners to move appropriate application giving necessary details within a period of four weeks from today. If such an application is received by the authority, the authority shall consider it in the light of law as laid down by this Court in the case of Jaikumari Amarbahadursingh & Ors. vs. State of Maharashtra & Anr., reported at 2009 (1) ALL MR 343, within a further period of four weeks.

Thus, leaving all other contentions open, we dispose of the present writ petitions. There shall be no order as to costs.
