We have perused the operative part of the judgment of the Family Court. The applicant-appellant has deposited a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- in this Court and it is stated on behalf of the appellant-applicant that a sum of Rs.40,000/- is deposited in the criminal proceedings that are pending in this Court. That shows, that an amount of Rs.1,40,000/- has been deposited by the applicant in this Court. Since a substantial part of the amount that is liable to be paid by the applicant is deposited by the applicant in this Court, we stay the judgment and decree of the Family Court as far as it directs the appellant to pay interim maintenance to the respondent at the rate of Rs.7,000/- per month, during the pendency of this appeal. The respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- deposited by the applicant as the amount of Rs.40,000/- is already withdrawn by the respondent.

The civil application is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
