Be that as it may, insofar as present proceedings are concerned they arose out of provisions of Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure against which regular remedy is available under law as decided by this Court in the case of **Yeshwant Maroti Kantode and ors. ..vs.. State of Mah. and anr.** reported in **2014 ALL MR**

(Cri) 998. Hence, with liberty to the applicants to take such steps as is available in law, the application stands disposed of.
