Prayer is to stay the effect and
operation of the decree passed by the trial
Court restraining the defendants from
interfering with the possession of the plaintiff.
Said decree stands modified by the first
appellate Court directing the defendants to
remove the encroachment.

status quo is operating and as the second
appeal is admitted, aforesaid position needs to
be maintained.
