On 11.09.2015, this Court has issued notice on both proceedings.

Writ Petition No. 4295 of 2014 filed by the applicant was dismissed in default on 07.01.2015 as nobody appeared for him on two occasions when the matter was called out.

Shri Bhise, Advocate holding for Shri Dhande, learned counsel for the applicant/ petitioner invites attention to the fact that there is delay of 159 days in filing the application for restoration.
