Communication dated 9-1-2015 which contains decision reached by respondent no. 2, Joint Director of Education in adherence to judgment of this Court dated 12-12-2013 in Writ Petition No. 5265/2012 is produced on record by the learned Government Pleader. It is marked as Exhibit 'X'.

In view of this development, Shri Dhore, learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that petitioners as also respondent no. 3, employee may be required to challenge this communication. He points out that this Court has protected the management in the matter by passing interim order on 12-12-2014. He seeks

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continuation of that order for period of six weeks.

Learned Government Pleader is opposing grant of any interim protection.

However, considering the fact that management has already protected and interim order is still operating, we continue this order till 15-6-2015.

The petitioners as also respondent no. 3 are at liberty to file appropriate petition challenging the communication at Exhibit 'X'.

With these directions and liberty, the writ petition is disposed of with no order as to costs.
