By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent no.2-Divisional Commissioner, Amravati Division, Amravati to investigate into the complaints made by the petitioner and take appropriate action.

The respondent nos.3 to 5 and the respondent no.6 have filed their affidavits-in-reply. It is stated in the said affidavits-in-reply that the enquiry is conducted in the complaint made by the petitioner and an enquiry report is submitted on 21.05.2015.
