Heard Shri D.N. Mehta, the learned Advocate for the applicant (original respondent No.1) and Shri S.P. Bhandarkar, the learned Advocate for the original petitioner. There was no appearance on behalf of the original respondent Nos. 2 and 5 when the writ petition is decided. The original respondent Nos.3 and 4 are not the contesting parties as recorded in the judgment dated 17-04-2015.

The original respondent No.1 has filed this application/counsel note praying for speaking to minutes, stating that at the time of disposal of the writ petition, it transpired that the trial Court has to be directed to dispose the civil suit till 30-09-2015, however it has not be incorporated in the judgment. Shri S.P. Bhandarkar, the learned Advocate for the original petitioner accepts this factual position.

In view of the above, the Civil Application/
