Prayer is to condone delay in filing the First Appeal.

It is submitted that in some what similar circumstances, this Court by order dated 22/10/2013 had condoned the delay of same extent.

Application is opposed by the learned counsel for non-applicant No.3 on the ground that reasons assigned are not sufficient. It is however not disputed that similar orders were passed in C.A.F. No.676 of 2013.
