court after filing of the charge-sheet . That being so, we make the
following order.

ORDER

Criminal Application (APL) No.765 of 2014 is disposed of
reserving liberty in favour of the applicants to apply for discharge if so
advised, after filing of the charge-sheet. If such an application for
discharge is made, the same shall be disposed of expeditiously and in
any case within a period of four months from today.
