Hence, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.1-Committee to decide the caste claim of the petitioner as early as possible and within a period of six months from today. It is made clear that the petitioner's service shall not be adversely affected till the decision of the respondent no.1-Committee and in case, the decision of the respondent no.1-Committee is adverse to the interest of the petitioner, his services shall not be adversely affected for a period of four months from the receipt of the same by the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms. No costs.
