**ORDER**

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Petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the 4<sup>th</sup> accused in Crime No.271/CR/OCW-III/PKD/2013 of CBCID, Palakkad for the offences punishable under Sections 489B and 489C read with Section 34 IPC.

3. On 24.05.2013 at 8.20 a.m., 6 numbers of fake Indian currency notes of the denomination of ₹500/- were handed over to the CSK Petronet Petrol Pump, Akalad. The same were seized from the petrol bunk by the police at 4 p.m. The petitioner has been in custody for the period from 26.12.2014 onwards.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

5. The contents of the CD, *prima facie*, reveal the

complicity of the petitioner. It is alleged that the Sub Inspector of Police had conducted a search at the house of A4, from where 7 fake Indian currency notes of the denomination of ₹500/- were seized. It has also come out that it was from A5, the petitioner had received the fake currency notes. The investigation has a long way to go. The allegations against the petitioner are very grave and serious. Considering the seriousness of the allegations against the petitioner and the present stage of investigation, I am of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail.

In the result, this Bail Application is dismissed.
