ORDER

Petitioner is the sole accused in Crime No.627/2015 of Kannur Town Police Station registered under Sections 354, 354A and 506 IPC. The allegation is that the petitioner, who was a colleague of the victim, outraged her modesty and threatened her.

2. Heard.

3. I have perused the complaint. The incident happened on different occasions. Though it is stated in the complaint that there were some witnesses to the incident, their names do not find a place in the witness list. Since there are some suspicious circumstances in the case, I am compelled to take the view that this is a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. In the result, this application is allowed on the following conditions:

- i) The petitioner shall be released on bail after interrogation on his executing a bond for ₹25,000/- with two solvent sureties each for the like sum if he is arrested by the Police in connection with this case.
- ii) He shall appear before the Investigating Officer for interrogation if he is so required by the Investigating Officer in writing.
- iii) He shall not destroy or tamper with evidence.
- iv) In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with the law.
