Petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C

2. Petitioners have allegedly assaulted the victim with a hammer causing serious injuries.

3. Heard.

4. The wound certificate shows that there was seizures, vomiting, headache and bleeding from the ear. The indication is that the victim sustained brain injury. This makes probable the prosecution version that the victim was attacked on the head with a heavy weapon like hammer. This is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail.

In the result, this application is dismissed.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioners will surrender before the investigating officer. He may do so if he is so advised.
