ORDER

Petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the husband of the first informant.

He is alleged to have assaulted her and subjected her to cruelty and thus committed the offences under Sections 324 and 498A of Indian Penal Code.

3. Heard.

4. The allegation is that the petitioner assaulted his wife with a piece of fire wood. It appears that bringing back peace to the family is not impossible. If the Petitioner happens to be detained the chances of reunion will be ruined. So I am inclined to grant the petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the result, this application is allowed.

1. The petitioner shall be released on bail after interrogation on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) with two solvent sureties for the like sum each if he is arrested by the police in connection with this case.

2. He shall appear before the investigating officer for

interrogation if he is so required by him in writing.

3. He shall not get himself involved in any other criminal case while he is on bail.

4. He shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses.

5. He shall not destroy or tamper with evidence.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with law.
