O R D E R

Petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. The petitioner is alleged to have committed the offences under Sections 366 A & 376 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 4, 5 (1) and 6 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.

3. It is alleged that he kidnapped the victim aged 17 years and committed rape on her.

4. Heard.

5. The victim is 17 years and the petitioner is 19 years. He has been in custody since 29.05.2015. His further detention is not necessary for completion of the investigation.

In the result, this application is allowed.

1. The petitioner will be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like

sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned.

2. He shall appear before the investigating officer between 11 a.m and 12 noon on all the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays for three months, or till the final report is filed, whichever is earlier.

3. He shall not threaten or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he, while on bail, get himself involved in any criminal case; nor shall he destroy or attempt to destroy the evidence or interfere with the investigation.

4. He shall not harass the defacto complainant or her relatives.

5. He shall not communicate or contact the victim.

If the petitioner violates any of the above conditions, the court of enquiry/trial is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with the law.
