Petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. The petitioner is alleged to have committed the offences under Sections 3(b) read with 4 and Section 5(m) read with Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 376 of IPC. The prosecution case is that he had sexual intercourse with a minor girl.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that final report has already been filed. Detention of the petitioner is not necessary for any purpose.

In the result, this application is allowed.

1)The petitioner will be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only)with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned.

2) The petitioner shall surrender his passport before

the lower concerned or if he does not have one, he shall file an affidavit to that effect within five days of his release.

3)The petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the court of enquiry or trial court as the case may be.

4)He shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he get himself involved in any other criminal case.

If the petitioner violates any of the above conditions, the court of enquiry/trial is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with the law.
