ORDER

Petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is accused of having committed the offences under Sections 323, 341 and 498A IPC. The victim is his wife. According to the prosecution, he wrongfully restrained her, assaulted her and subjected her to cruelty.

3. Heard.

4. There is no allegation that the victim sustained any serious injuries. Since this is a family matter, the attempt of the court should be to restore harmony to the family. So, I am inclined to grant the prayer of the petitioner.

In the result, this application is allowed.

1)The petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only)with two solvent sureties each for the like sum if he is arrested by the Police in connection with this case.

2)He shall appear before the Investigating Officer for interrogation if he is so required by him in writing.

3)He shall not destroy or tamper with evidence.

4)He shall not contact or communicate with her or enter her residential premises.

5)He shall not harass the de facto complainant or her relatives.

If the petitioner surrender before the Magistrate this order is not applicable and the learned Magistrate may pass appropriate orders.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with the law.
