ORDER

Petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioners are alleged to have committed the offences under Sections 143, 147, 341, 332 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case is that they assaulted a KSRTC bus driver and thus prevented him from discharging his duty.

4. Heard.

5. The victim did not sustain any external injuries. Detention of the petitioners is not necessary for investigation.

In the result, this application is allowed.

1. The petitioners shall be released on bail after interrogation on their executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) each with two solvent sureties for the like sum each if they are arrested by the police in connection with this case.

2. They shall appear before the investigating

officer between 10 a.m and 11 a.m on 23rd and 31st of this month.

3. They shall not get themselves involved in any other criminal case while they are on bail.

4. They shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses.

5. They shall not destroy or tamper with evidence.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with law.

If the petitioners surrender before the Magistrate this order is not applicable and the learned Magistrate may pass appropriate orders.
