2. Petitioner is accused in Crime No.390 of 2015 of Karamana Police station registered for the offences under Secs.406, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code. The prosecution case is that he obtained a loan from a bank on depositing certified copy of his title deed. He made a false statement that the original title deed had been lost. It was later disclosed that he had deposited the original title deed with another bank to secure a loan.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The facts of the case clearly indicate commission of the offences of cheating by the petitioner. This is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the bail application is dismissed.
