ORDER

Petition filed under Sec.439 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the 2nd accused in Crime No.1449 of 2014 of Muvattupuzha Police station registered for the offences under Secs.465, 468, 471, 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code. He is the Managing Director of a private limited company. He submitted a loan application before the South Indian Bank. Along with the application, he produced certain documents. On the basis of those documents, the bank granted him a loan of Rs.2,42,00,000/-. Some of the documents produced by him were found to be false later.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.06.2015. The amount now due to the bank is about 7 crores. His earlier bail application was dismissed by this court on 26.06.2015. No subsequent development has

been pleaded. The 2nd bail application cannot be entertained.

In the result, the bail application is dismissed.
