Petition filed under Section 439(1) Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is alleged to have committed the offences under Sections 120(B),115,143,147,148,341,324,326,307 r/w 149 IPC.

3. He is the 12th accused. The prosecution case is that he along with the co-accused assaulted the victim with intent to murder him pursuant to a conspiracy and they assaulted him with a sword causing him very serious injuries.

4. Heard.

5. Petitioner is said to have informed the other accused about the movements of the victim to facilitate the assault by the co-accused. The victim sustained very serious injuries. The petitioner has been in custody since 4.7.2015. His release at this stage will adversely affect the investigation. So I am not inclined to grant his prayer.

In the result, this Bail Application is dismissed.
