**ORDER**

Petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the 3<sup>rd</sup> accused in Crime No.206 of 2015 of Kuttampuzha Police Station. He is accused of having committed the offence under Sections 2, 3 read with Section 25(1-13), Arms Act 1959 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case is that he along with the co-accused was found to be in possession of a loaded country made gun, without licence for its possession.

4. Heard.

5. The petitioner has been in custody since 11.07.2015. His co-accused have already been released on bail. His further detention is not necessary for completion of the investigation. So, I am inclined to grant the prayer of the petitioner.

In the result, this application is allowed.

*1)The petitioner will be released on bail on his executing a bond for 1,00,000/-(Rupees one lakh only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum*

*to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned.*

- 2) The petitioner shall appear before the investigating officer between 10 a.m and 11 a.m. every Wednesday for five month, or till the final report is filed, whichever is earlier.*
- 3)He shall surrender his passport before the lower court concerned or if he does not have one, he shall file an affidavit to that effect within five days of his release.*
- 4)He shall not leave India without the previous permission of the court of enquiry or trial court, as the case may be.*
- 5)He shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he get himself involved in any other criminal case.*
- 6)He shall co-operate with investigation of the case.*

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with the law.
