Petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C

2. Petitioners are the accused in Crime No.931 of 2015 of Ernakulam Town North Police Station. They are said to have committed the offences under Sections 457, 461, 511, 380, 506(ii), 323, 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case is that at midnight on 22.06.2015 they attempted to break open the ATM with the intention of committing theft.

4. Heard.

5. It is true that the petitioners have been in custody since 23.06.2015 or 25.06.2015. They came from Uttar Pradesh. Two of the petitioners were caught red-handed while they were attempted to break open the ATM at Cemetheri junction in Ernakulam town. The nature of the case does not incline me to grant bail.
