O R D E R

Petition filed under Sec.439 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the accused in Crime No.618 of 2015 of Pangode Police station registered for the offences punishable under Secs.9(l)(m) read with Sec.10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012. The prosecution allegation is that, the petitioner committed repeated sexual assaults on a minor girl on several occasions. The petitioner was arrested on 07.07.2015.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

Considering the stage in investigation and the fact that the petitioner is in custody for more than 80 days, bail is granted to the petitioner with the following conditions.

i. The petitioner shall be released on

bail on his executing a bond for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate having jurisdiction.

ii. The sureties shall be the persons permanently residing in the State of Kerala and shall produce documents to establish their identity and solvency.

iii. The petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer between 10.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on every Monday and Thursday until final report is filed.

iv. The petitioner shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he tamper with the evidence.

v. The petitioner shall not involve in any other offence during the period of bail.

In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to

cancel the bail in accordance with law without referring
the matter to this Court.
