ORDER

Petition filed under Sec.439 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the 1st accused in Crime No.60 of 2015 of Anchal Excise Range registered for the offence under Sec.55(i) of the Kerala Abkari Act. The prosecution allegation is that, on 24.08.2015, the petitioner was found in possession of 12.500 litres of Indian Made Foreign Liquor intended for the purpose of sale.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other offence so far.

Considering the fact that the petitioner was arrested on 24.08.2015 and stage of investigation, bail is granted to the petitioner with the following conditions.

i. The petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate having jurisdiction.

ii. The sureties shall be the persons permanently residing in the State of Kerala and shall produce documents to establish their identity and solvency.

iii. The petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer between 10.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on every Monday and Thursday until final report is filed.

iv. The petitioner shall not intimidate or attempt to influence the witnesses, nor shall he tamper with the evidence.

v. The petitioner shall not involve in any other offence during the period of bail.

In case of violation of any of the above

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conditions, the learned Magistrate is empowered to cancel the bail in accordance with law without referring the matter to this Court.
