ORDER

Application for pre-arrest bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

2. Petitioner is the accused in Crime No.995 of 2015 of Kazhakootam Police Station registered for offences punishable under Sections 406, 419, 420 and 427 I.P.C.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that the petitioner while working as an Accountant in a Bakery misappropriated an amount of Rs.25,000/- from the defacto complainant's shop. It is further alleged that he forged a cheque leaf of the defacto complainant and withdrew money.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

5. Considering the nature of allegations, I am of the view that the petitioner is entitled to plead for pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Therefore, following directions are made :

1. Petitioner shall surrender before the investigating officer within a period of one week from today and submit himself for interrogation. In that event, the petitioner shall be released on bail on executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
2. The sureties shall produce documents to establish their identity and solvency.
3. Petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.
4. Petitioner shall not influence or intimidate witnesses.

If any of the above conditions is violated by the petitioner, the learned Magistrate having jurisdiction is free to cancel the bail.
